

Windows 10 End-of-Life



OVERVIEW:

Microsoft will stop providing technical assistance, feature updates, and security updates for Windows 10 on October 14, 2025. As a result, your system may become vulnerable to cyberattacks, malware, and data breaches. Continuing to use Windows 10 after October 14 may also mean your system does not comply with federal and provincial health information regulations, potentially resulting in legal and financial penalties. HOW TO CHECK YOUR WINDOWS VERSION

- ♦ Press the Windows Key + R to open the Run dialog
- ♦ Type 'winver' and press Enter
- ♦ A window will appear showing your Windows version and build number
- ♦ If you are running on a Windows 10 version, you will need to upgrade



CAN I UPGRADE MY CURRENT DEVICE?

- ◆ Download and run the <u>PC Health Check tool from Microsoft</u>.
- ♦ The tool will let you know if your device meets the requirements for Windows 11
